

Memorial rights

Graves at Cardiff do not have gravestones, instead oak memorial plaques mounted on the walls of the memorial shelter commemorate people's names and dates. These plaques are displayed for a period of ten years, after which we use the latest contact details that you have provided to offer you the option to extend the period of display. If you choose not to extend the rights, or if we receive no response from you, the plaque will be taken down to make way for another. It is important to let us know any change of contact information. Income from memorial rights contributes to the upkeep of the burial ground.

Grouped plaques

For some people it is important for their plaques to be placed together; to enable this, blank plaques need to be inserted to secure that space. Blank plaques need to be purchased when the first memorial plaque is ordered.

Later on, when the second memorial plaque is ordered and needs to be placed alongside the original plaque, there will be two charges: i) the cost of the new memorial plaque, and ii) the charge for removing the blank and slotting the new plaque into the existing array. These charges are payable at the prevailing rate when the second plaque is ordered. Please note that prices are reviewed each year and generally rise with inflation.
