





# An enchanting place

The woodland at Cothiemuir Hill is a peaceful, natural place. Somewhere special to spend time listening to the birdsong in the surrounding woodland, admiring the Neolithic stones, and taking in the view towards Bennachie. A place of escape, away from it all.

The burial ground is a central part of the historic Forbes Estate, located within the beautiful Strathdon landscape.

As the hardwood trees in the burial ground next to the ancient pinewood have matured, a variety of wildlife has been attracted to it including red squirrels, pine martens, both red and roe deer, badgers and foxes. Overhead you may see ospreys and buzzards.

The site is managed to encourage wildflowers in the spring and summer.

# How it works

You can purchase rights for a full burial, ashes interment or ashes scattering at the burial ground...

#### In advance

Visit the burial ground and spend time there getting to know it and deciding whether it's right for you.

Complete an online application or download a pdf form from our website. If you'd like a printed information pack, please contact the office.

Pre-purchase at today's rate. Options available to pay by standing order.

## When planning a funeral

Complete an online application form, or download an interment form to let us know your plans for the day so that we can help you achieve your wishes.

Make the arrangements yourself or ask your funeral director to do this for you. Book the date and time with us. Burials

may take place 10am-3pm and at weekends by special arrangement.

#### **Practicalities**

We recommend stout footwear as the ground is uneven. A foldable chair is a good idea for those who find it difficult to stand and remember, there's no such thing as bad weather, just the wrong sort of clothes...





# More time and space

# **Flowers**

Consider using flowers from your garden, or a friend's, or produce from the veg patch to create a hand-tied bouquet. Ask florists to use these or locally grown flowers. No plastic, Oasis foam or wire, please.

Think about scattering petals from a basket or single stems into the grave.

# Pets

Dogs offer comfort and companionship, especially at funerals. Dogs on leads are welcome at the burial ground.

A pet's ashes may be included in its owner's grave at the time of interment.


# **Memorial stones**

Memorial rights are granted for the display of a memorial stone on the grave. In keeping with the wild and natural character of the burial ground, memorial stones need to be rustic in shape and laid flat to the ground.

Letter cutting can be undertaken by a family member, local stonemason or memorial mason. In keeping with the natural setting, the stone should not be cut or polished, and no paint should be used in the letters.

# **Memorial trees**

We have a number of spaces where we can offer a place to plant a native tree at the natural burial ground in memory of someone special. New native trees will enhance the development of the extended woodland, improving biodiversity and encouraging more wildlife to visit.


#### 6. Updates and how we use your personal data

We share details of the event and the people involved with the custodian to prepare them for your arrival. We may also use it for statistical analysis. We are obliged to keep a register of all burials and interments, recording the date of burial, names in full, age, address and grave number. By law, this data must be accessible to the public.

Venue (Tip: You can have a funeral service anywhere - at your local pub, hotel, your home, or even outdoors with a simple committal beforehand, and maybe a wake there too after the funeral.)
