Trees inside the burial meadow, there are a few select positions close to the edges, where robust cages will guard these new trees against being nibbled by livestock. The slate plaque dedicating the tree to someone's memory is mounted on the wooden cage around the tree, with the details given above. Plaques will be displayed for an initial period of 10 years (due to the projected lifespan of the materials), and you will have the option to renew/extend the periods at the end of this term.

The areas surrounding the trees must not be gardened and nothing should be placed or planted without consent from the Custodian. Anything that appears without our consent will be removed. Please make sure that this is right for you before you commit to the burial ground as this will not suit everyone.

We will send you a receipt for your payment. Each tree plaque is made to order and will be placed as soon as possible (usually within 1 month). Plaques are displayed for a period of ten years, after which the condition of the frame will be assessed and we will offer you the option to extend the period of display or to choose an alternative arrangement. In the unlikely event that plaques suffer from vandalism, theft, accidental or malicious damage, these will be replaced at cost.

5. How we use your personal data and updates
