An enchanting place

The woodland at Cothiemuir Hill is a peaceful, natural place. Somewhere special to spend time listening to the birdsong in the surrounding woodland, admiring the Neolithic stones, and taking in the view towards Bennachie. A place of escape, away from it all.

The burial ground is a central part of the historic Forbes Estate, located within the beautiful Strathdon landscape.

As the hardwood trees in the burial ground next to the ancient pinewood have matured, a variety of wildlife has been attracted to it including red squirrels, pine martens, both red and roe deer, badgers and foxes. Overhead you may see ospreys and buzzards.

The site is managed to encourage wildflowers in the spring and summer.

In advance

Visit the burial ground and spend time there getting to know it and deciding whether it's right for you.

We recommend stout footwear as the ground is uneven. A foldable chair is a good idea for those who find it difficult to stand and remember, there's no such thing as bad weather, just the wrong sort of clothes...

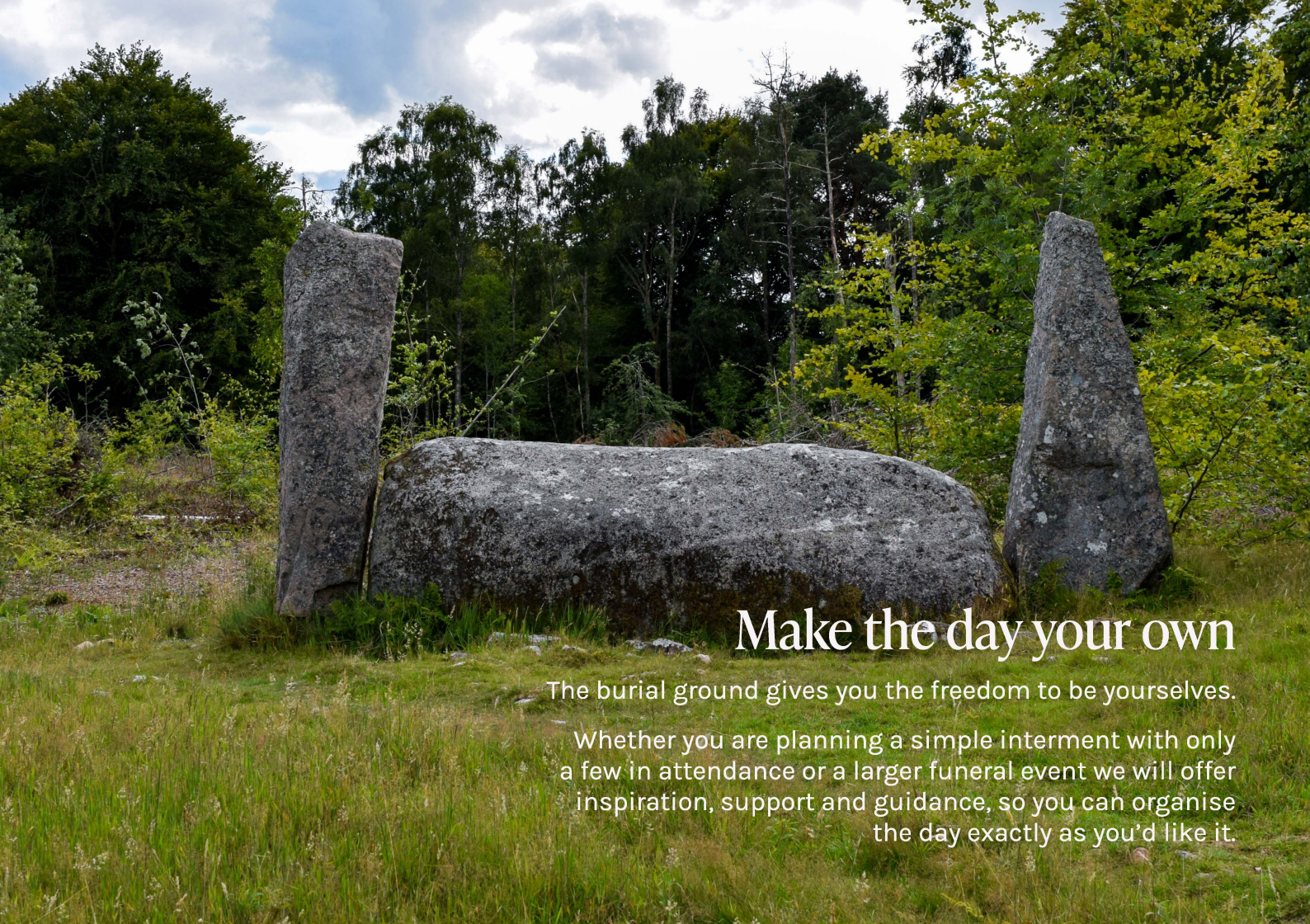
An unhurried and private place away from the hustle of daily life. Somewhere to remember, replenish and reflect. A place of peace and solitude, when you need it, and love.

Make the day your own

The burial ground gives you the freedom to be yourselves.

Whether you are planning a simple interment with only a few in attendance or a larger funeral event we will offer inspiration, support and guidance, so you can organise the day exactly as you'd like it.



Flowers

Consider using flowers from your garden, or a friend's, or produce from the veg patch to create a hand-tied bouquet. Ask florists to use these or locally grown flowers. No plastic, Oasis foam or wire, please.

Think about scattering petals from a basket or single stems into the grave.

Pets

Dogs offer comfort and companionship, especially at funerals. Dogs on leads are welcome at the burial ground.

A pet's ashes may be included in its owner's grave at the time of interment.

Memorial stones

Memorial rights are granted for the display of a memorial stone on the grave. In keeping with the wild and natural character of the burial ground, memorial stones need to be rustic in shape and laid flat to the ground.

Letter cutting can be undertaken by a family member, local stonemason or memorial mason. In keeping with the natural setting, the stone should not be cut or polished, and no paint should be used in the letters.



Memorial trees

We have a number of spaces where we can offer a place to plant a native tree at the natural burial ground in memory of someone special. New native trees will enhance the development of the extended woodland, improving biodiversity and encouraging more wildlife to visit.



Finding the spot

The plots are carefully mapped and their locations are recorded and shared with you so that you'll know where to visit.

If you struggle with any of these, don't worry, we will be able to flag the spot for you. You'll be able to return to the spot at any time and you'll have helped preserve a much loved landscape for future generations to enjoy.

Location	Castle Forbes Keig Alford AB33 8BL
Access	Open year-round. The gate into the burial ground is not locked. Please let wheelchair users know that there are no paths across the grass.
Description	The woodland at Cothiemuir Hill is a peaceful, natural place, with the Neolithic stones nestled among the trees, and a beautiful in the view towards Bennachie. The burial ground is divided into named areas, each of which offers something different.
Ethos	Keep things simple, natural and sustainable. Real countryside preserved for future generations.
On-site facilities	There is car parking on site. No rooms, chapels, toilets or mortuary facilities on site. The nearest public WCs are at Houghton County Park , or you can contact the custodian ahead of time to request access to the Forbes Estate Office toilet.

Procedures

Prices and forms	A price list and all forms are available on the website: www.leedam.com/locations/cothiemuir-hill/forms-and-prices
Provisional booking	Call 01600 716438 to make a provisional funeral booking, after the death has been certified, and let us know the requested date, name of the deceased, your own contact details and any prior purchase information.
Confirmation	We will check the calendar to make sure the date is available, then contact the gravedigger and custodian to make sure they are also available before confirming the booking.
Submit forms	Complete an online application form, or download a PDF from the website and at least three days before the event email it to cothiemuir@leedam.co.uk with a scanned copy of the Coroner's Order of Burial or a Registrar's Certificate (or cremation certificate for an ashes interment).
Payments	We will send you invoices and payment is made by bank transfer. We required payment no less than two days before the event. The gravedigger is paid separately, and will also require payment before the event. We will send you a receipt and confirm that everything is OK.
Embalming	Embalming is not permitted. Embalming fills the body with toxic chemicals, which we do not wish to introduce into the soil. We would only accept embalmed remains in exceptional circumstances, e.g. repatriation.
Choosing a plot	The burial ground is divided into nine areas with different prices. Arrange a family visit to the burial ground with the Custodian (07808 003285) to choose an area and be shown the next available plot.
Double plots	Plots are single depth. Double plots are arranged side by side. The second plot can be paid for in full or costs can be spread over 10 or 20 months by setting up a monthly standing order (extra admin charge applies). If undecided, we can provisionally reserve it for 1 year, after which it may be offered to others.

Coffins etc	<p>Choose an eco-coffin, casket or shroud. All materials, including linings and clothing, should be natural and biodegradable. No veneered MDF or chipboard, please. Standard nameplates are OK or a handwritten card label with the deceased's name and dates.</p> <p><i>TIP - Use calico canvas instead of polythene Crem Film.</i></p>
Coffin size	<p>Please measure and include the true maximum external dimensions of the coffin on the Interment Forms. If in doubt please call us.</p>
Grave digging	<p>Our nominated gravedigger will prepare the grave ready for your arrival. Graves are single depth 1.3m; double plots are arranged side by side. Payment is made directly to the grave digger. We will send you a pro forma invoice with instructions before the funeral.</p>
On the day	<p>There is usually only one burial on the day and time is not limited. The Custodian will be there to meet and direct you. The vehicular gate into the meadow will be open for the hearse, limousine and family mourners with limited mobility who display the priority parking sign in the windscreen. More info: www.leedam.com/advice/disabled-access</p> <p><i>TIP - Estate cars are popular with families instead of the formal hearse.</i></p>
Dogs and pets	<p>Dogs offer comfort and companionship, especially at funerals. Dogs on leads are welcome at the burial meadow.</p>
Music	<p>There is no electrical power supply in the burial ground. Make sure that battery-powered speakers are powerful enough to deliver good sound quality. Live, acoustic music is always beautiful.</p>
What to wear	<p>Wellies/hiking shoes (not high-heels); warm, windproof clothes.</p> <p><i>TIP - Bring folding chairs, scarves, hats and blankets for the elderly.</i></p>
Carrying the coffin	<p>The ground is uneven, so it is recommended to carry the coffin underarm rather than on shoulders, feet first. Set up trestles at regular resting points if the carry distance is long.</p>
Webbing	<p>Our gravedigger supplies sanitised webbing, so there is no need to bring your own.</p>
Flowers	<p>Seasonal flowers from the garden or produce from the veg patch are perfect. Please let florists know it is for a natural burial, so no plastic, Oasis foam or wire. Arrangements should be taken away at the end of the event. Please let the custodian know if a posy of flowers is to be left on the grave.</p> <p><i>TIP - Bring a basket of petals from the garden to scatter into the grave.</i></p>

Items in the grave	Additional ashes can be included in the grave, please include details on the application form. You can also include natural tributes e.g. wooden boat, sea shells; a sealed museum jar with significant pieces, or other inert objects.
After the funeral	We will issue a certificate of interment, by email, with the precise grave location details. This will be in pdf format for sharing.
Finding the grave	The certificate of interment will include links to Google Maps, GPS coordinates and the What3Words address of the grave. The What3Words mobile app is an easy way to navigate to the grave. If there is any concern, we can flag the spot.
Memorials	Memorial rights are granted for the display of a memorial stone on the grave. Rights last for a period of 25 years after which they are renewable. The memorial can be ordered on the Interment Form or a separate application form is available on our website. Memorial stones need to be rustic in shape and laid flat to the ground. Local field or river stones are ideal - square cut or polished stones are not to be placed.
Plants and trees	We have a number of spaces where we can plant a native tree in memory of someone special. To protect wildlife and bereaved families from unwanted change, nothing should be planted and no seeds should be scattered without our consent.

Baby & infant funerals	Scotland has a scheme in place, whereby no fees should be charged for the burial of a child or person under the age of 18 (including stillborn and foetal remains), which we support. https://leedam.com/advice/childrens-funerals/
Direct burials	A direct/simple natural burial can be arranged for families who do not wish to attend the burial. Full grave location details will be provided on the burial certificate.

Maintenance	The burial ground is maintained as woodland surrounded meadow and the burial areas will be mown occasionally throughout the year.
Long term security	The land is part of the historic Forbes Estate. This gives it a very high level of protection. There is no real chance of the land being redeveloped at any time in the future. www.leedam.com/future-security
